The attention of bidders submitting proposals for the above-referenced project is called to the following Addendum to the specifications. The items set forth herein, whether of omission, addition, substitution or other change, are all to be included in and form a part of the proposed Contract Documents for the work. Bidders shall acknowledge this Addendum in the Bid Proposal by inserting its number on Page BP-1.

Item 1: Detailed Specifications, Part 1 – General, 1.1 General Description, page DS-1 has been revised:

- a. The original bid called for a total of four (4) pickleball courts to be painted over the two (2) tennis courts. The Town has now opted to have only two (2) pickleball courts painted, one on each tennis court.
- b. A difference was pointed out between the height of the pickle ball net (34” in the middle) vs. the height of the tennis court net (36” in the middle). It is the Town’s intention to use the same center line whether or not the same nets are used, so the painting will be for courts going in the same north - south direction of play.

Item 2: Detailed Specifications, Part 3 – Execution, 3.4 Line Painting, page DS-6 has been clarified:

- a. It was suggested that a change in the current specified color combination of blue and green to an alternative color combination of light green and dark green might afford a lower price. The Town will leave the specifications of the bid "as is", and reserves the right to choose the colors after award. Bidder shall provide in their base price a cost as specified in the bid. This includes the color of the lines for pickleball courts.
- b. If the contractor desires to offer an alternative color system to their base bid, bidder shall submit the alternative color option and a separate DEDUCT amount as an optional price. The Town may or may not choose this option at their sole discretion. This will not be a factor in the basis of award. Please attach a separate sheet of paper if offering a DEDUCT from the base price amount.

- a. Furnish and install all labor, materials and equipment needed to complete repairs, resurfacing, and repainting two (2) tennis courts (120' x 110' each) and one (1) basketball court (70' x 120'), and walkway (8 1/2' x 39') between basketball and tennis courts in Addison Park as specified herein Bid GL-2015-09. Repainting includes two tennis courts, one basketball court, and two pickleball courts. Price includes painting pavement outside fence of tennis courts and repair of 1085 linear feet of cracks (approximately 600 l.f. on tennis court and 485 l.f. on basketball court). The actual payment for crack repair will be adjusted based on field measurement of in place crack repair using the unit price submitted below.
