Glastonbury Apple Harvest Festival Finalizes Entertainment Schedule for 2015

Glastonbury, CT – July 23, 2015 – This October will usher in the 41st Anniversary of the immensely popular Glastonbury Apple Harvest Festival, taking place on October 16-18. This annual event brings in over 15,000 patrons with a bevy of amusement rides, fireworks, fantastic food, the “Harvest Pub” beer and wine garden, and an elaborate “Vendor Village” which features over 100 vendor booths. This year the Glastonbury Chamber of Commerce is proud to announce the return of three stages worth of local, original music.

Beginning Friday night, October 16 attendees to this year’s festival will be treated to artists ranging from indie rock and jazz to country, reggae, and hip hop to everything in between. Once again 40 acts have been confirmed for this year’s festival, including recent CT Music Awards winners Canyon (2015 Song of the Year), Heather Fay (2015 Best Folk/Traditional), Sarah LeMieux (2015 Album of the Year and 2015 Best Jazz), Political Animals (2015 Best Hip Hop), and a handful of other winners from previous years. The festival will also feature the return of Glastonbury/South Windsor residents, Bonsai Trees, as well as, Gravitonik, which features 12 and 13 year old musicians playing various classic rock covers.
