1	<p>“SHALL THE ORDINANCE, PROPOSED BY CITIZEN PETITION, WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS, BE APPROVED:</p> <p>CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 3 OF THE GLASTONBURY CODE OF ORDINANCES IS AMENDED TO INSERT THE FOLLOWING AS DIVISION 4: THE 34.83-ACRE PARCEL KNOWN AS BUCKINGHAM PARK OWNED BY THE TOWN OF GLASTONBURY (ALSO REFERRED TO AS “BUCKINGHAM RECREATION AREA” IN THE 1990-2000 GLASTONBURY PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT) SHALL BE (1) RETAINED AS OPEN SPACE AND PARK LAND, AND (2) USED FOR RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES. THERE SHALL BE NO FURTHER BUILDING OR CONSTRUCTION WITHIN BUCKINGHAM PARK, EXCEPT FOR MINOR STRUCTURES THAT SUPPORT EXISTING PARK FUNCTIONS, WITHOUT VOTER REFERENDUM?”</p>	3,338	1,851




