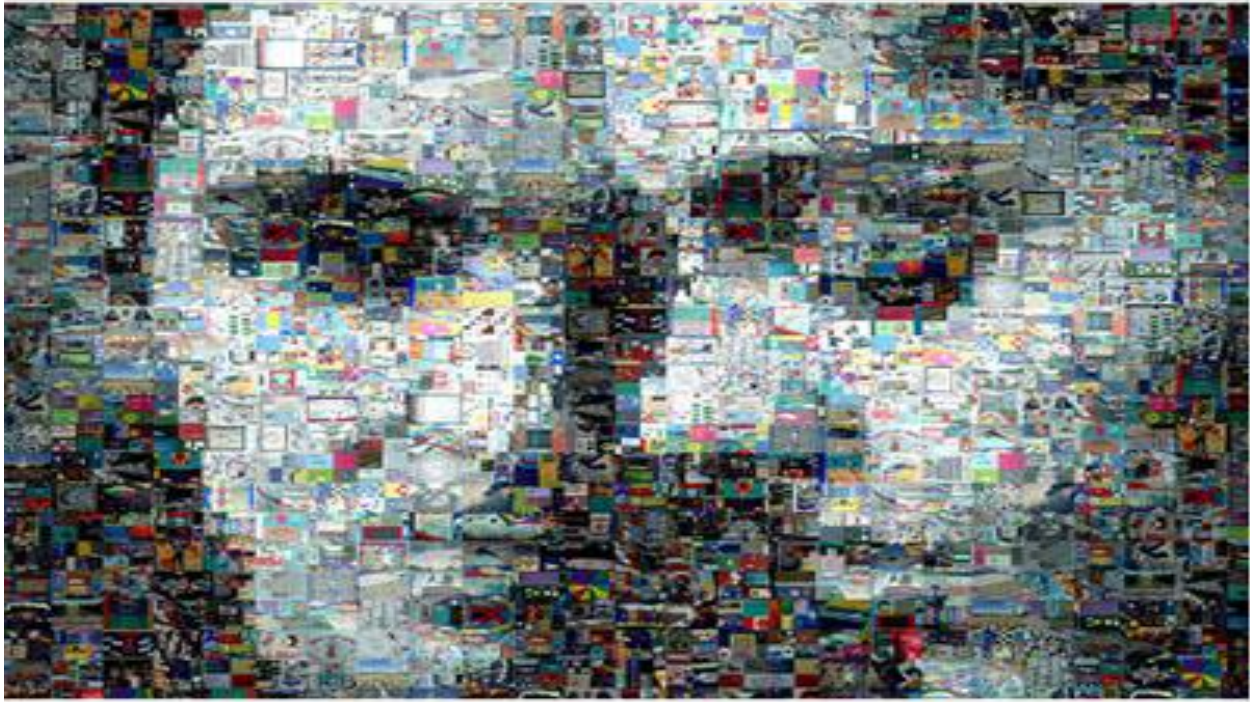


GONE, BUT NOT FORGOTTEN
