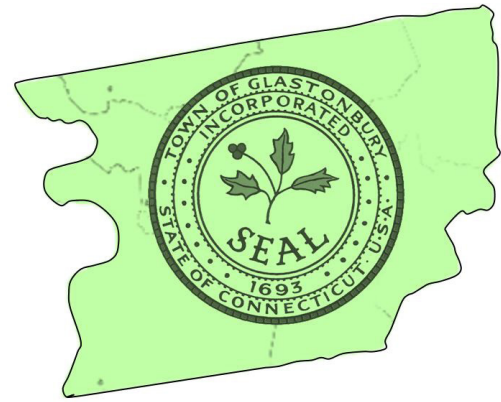


Sustainability in Glastonbury Event
