- 2. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES - Minutes of the Meeting of August 8, 2018.** Linda DeGroff moved to accept the minutes and Debra DeVries-Dalton seconded the motion. The minutes were accepted.
- 3. 260 CIDER MILL ROAD – replacement of existing pump station – Michael J. Bisi, Superintendent of Sanitation.** No vote – agreed with plan as presented, with no landscape plans at this time. Will re-visit once built. Small site - very tight. Possibly lends itself to natural plants such as Carex, Forbs and Ferns, but would be better decided after date. It may not need landscaping at all because of the small site and surroundings in place already. Consider darker color for building to blend into natural surroundings.
- 4. 2183 MAIN STREET – modifications to approved landscaping plan for The Micah House and Chapel at the Thomas Hale Homestead– Jonathan Russell, project manager for First Church of Christ.** Approved as presented. Advised to wait until spring to move Memorial Dogwood. Questioned whether use of chain between granite posts instead of wooden pickets is in keeping with the period. Suggested looking at wooden rails instead. Move to accept by Debra DeVries-Dalton, seconded by Della Winans. Approved.
- 5. OTHER BUSINESS –** Update on Hubbard Green Memorial – planting almost done. Lighting going in by Town forces, irrigation in, patio raised and new granite curbs on front. New mulch to come, grass seed done.
