Answer The proposed addition is expected to reduce the current 89 spaces to approximately

77. The square footage of the current building requires 57 spaces under Building Zone Regulations. The proposed addition of 3,746+/- will require an additional 7 spaces for a total of 64 spaces in the main lot. There is also on-street parking as well

parking at the bank next door when the bank is closed.
