

**MINUTES – GLASTONBURY RECREATION COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING – June 20, 2019**

The Glastonbury Recreation Commission held a Regular Meeting on Thursday, June 20, 2019, at the Glastonbury Parks & Recreation Department, 2143 Main Street, Glastonbury, Connecticut.

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 a.m.

1. Correspondence:

2. Minutes:

The minutes of the March 21, 2019 regular meeting were accepted as written.

3. Committee Reports:

Great Pond Preserve: The Great Pond Preserve Stewardship held their annual clean-up day on Saturday, April 18th at 9:00 a.m. Lisa Zerio and Town Councilman, Whit Osgood, were in attendance. The Great Pond Stewardship Committee, at their last meeting, requested the release of \$6,000 to Glastonbury. \$2,000 of the funds were for maintenance of the Preserve, and \$4,000 for a gate. Upon further inspection of the area on the clean-up day, it was determined that a gate in that area is not necessary and possibly the funds could be put towards more signage.

4. Director's Report:

- Lisa Zerio gave an overview of the summer programs and concert series. The Recreation Supervisors have been working diligently and very long days putting the final touches on summer programs.

5. Old Business

- Indoor Aquatic Facility: Lisa Zerio reported that Moser Pilon will be at the Town Council meeting on Tuesday, June 25, 2019. They will be presenting two more options for the study. One will be a 50 meter pool, and the other a single pool.
- Grange Pool: Lisa Zerio stated that Grange Pool renovations are complete and the pool opened on Wednesday, July 12th. The lifeguards have been getting positive feedback from the public.

6. New Business:

Schedule of Fees & Charges: The FY 2019-20 Schedule of Fees and Charges were approved unanimously.


7. Any Other Business to Come Before the Commission:
