3. 592 HEBRON AVENUE – proposal for landscape modifications as well as façade modifications and new signage at the Wheels (Citgo) gas station – Planned Commerce Zone – Tim Blakeman, Clark Construction, applicant

The plan was presented by Mark Smith. The Committee had the following thoughts:

- 1. Add more evergreens to the plan;
- 2. A more considered design should be created, especially around the sign;
- 3. Change out the Cycas (tropical plant) for something more suited for our zone, possible ilex densa or glabra;
- 4. The Committee would like to make a strong recommendation to add 6 trees to the west portion of the property; this is a large open area that could take a few trees. This recommendation depends on the property having no restrictions for trees; and
- 5. The Committee would also like a plan of watering and maintenance of these trees to make sure they grow successfully.

The Committee gave Bob Shipman the authority to review the revised plan and make the final vote/decision.

Jarrod made motion to accept as revised; Debra seconded; all in favor 7-0.

4. OTHER BUSINESS

70 Oak Street revisions

Attorney Meg Hope presented along with Landscape Architect Kevin Grindle. Upon reviewing last month's minutes, all the revisions had been made per the Committee suggestions. All members were very happy with the end result; they felt Kevin did a great job.

331 Hebron Avenue
