1) Introductions

2) Updates

a) Bike Walk Glastonbury

W Mis provided an update received through J Stein. Bike Walk Glastonbury is interested in providing signage along the route between the multiuse trail and the start of the existing trail at Smith School. This would guide bicyclists and pedestrians from one trail to the other, as well as inform motorists of bicyclists and pedestrians on the route. The signage will be coordinated with the timing of trail completion.

b) Town departments

i. Engineering

W Mis provided an update as received through Town engineers. The remaining easement required for the multiuse trail has been executed, and design and permitting of the trail are complete. We are now waiting for final finding approval from DOT. Once the finding agreement is signed and returned, the project will be advertised for bid. The likely schedule is for a bid in the last quarter of 2019 with construction in 2020.

ii. Parks and Recreation

W Mis provided an update as received through A Park. CT Cycling Advancement Program (CCAP) was unable to secure a coach for a fall start to the youth cycling team program. They are working to get someone on board for a spring start.

iii. Police

J Hodder reported that sidewalk repair is occurring along Main Street.

Cross walk signs are being destroyed by motorists hitting them/running them over with vehicles. Signs are sent to Public Works to repair, and new signs cost around \$120 each. Mis asked if Officer Magrey could (again) address pedestrian and bike safety in his weekly Glastonbury Citizen column, and include the cost of pedestrian crossing signs.

iv. Health

W Mis reported that she will participate in a CRCOG conference call later this month regarding the Bike Share RFP.
