Re: CGS Sec. 8-24 – Reserve for Land Acquisition and Preservation

The Council is considering a referendum question for this November seeking voter approval of a \$3M authorization and appropriation for land acquisition and preservation. The bond resolution process requires referral to the Town Plan & Zoning Commission under CGS Section 8-24.

By action at its Tuesday, July 14, 2020 meeting, the Council referred this matter to the Commission.

Since the Reserve was established in the late 1980's, 50± parcels totaling 2,200± acres have been purchased by the Town with bond authorizations approved at 11 separate referenda. Discussions now in progress could significantly reduce the \$800,000 available bond authorization. Accordingly, the Council is considering a proposal for referendum this fall.
