

November 3, 2020 State Election

The Electors of the Town of Glastonbury are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Presidential and Vice-Presidential electors, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative and Registrar of Voters.
- II. To vote on the following town question for the approval or disapproval, a vote of "YES" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "NO" being a vote for disapproval:
 - 1. SHALL THE TOWN OF GLASTONBURY APPROPRIATE \$3,000,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS AND ACQUISITION OF LAND PURSUANT TO THE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TOWN'S RESERVE FOR LAND ACQUISITION AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION?

The full text of such question with explanatory text, printed in accordance with §9-369b, is available by contacting the Town Clerk's Office and published to the Town of Glastonbury website (Per Governor's Executive Order #7I, Sec, 19c).

The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to Sec. 312 of the Glastonbury Town Charter.
