TOWN OFFICES REOPEN TO THE PUBLIC EFFECTIVE JUNE 1

Town offices will reopen to the public effective Tuesday, June 1. UNVACCINATED visitors and staff will be required to wear face coverings over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building and Plexiglas, floor markings, and other safety measures will be in place to encourage social distancing. Additional protocols for public use may vary by Town facility. For resident convenience, alternative service delivery processes will continue, such as virtual and drop-box/by mail services.

Town Hall will resume passport processing services effective Wednesday, June 2. This service is available by appointment only and town residency is NOT required. Appointments must be made at least 24 hours in advance and can be scheduled by contacting the Customer Service Center at **(860) 652-7710** or customerservicecenter@glastonbury-ct.gov during standard office hours (Mon-Fri, 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM). Appointments are available on Wednesdays, between 8:30 AM and 3:30 PM.
