# SEWER USE BILLS PAYABLE BY DEC. 1

Sewer Use charges are due November 1, 2021 and payable by December

1, 2021. Unpaid Sewer Use charges will be considered delinquent as of December 2, 2021. Interest is charged at a rate of 1 ½% per month back to the due date of November 1, 2021 in accordance with the provisions of C.G.S. Sec 12-146.
