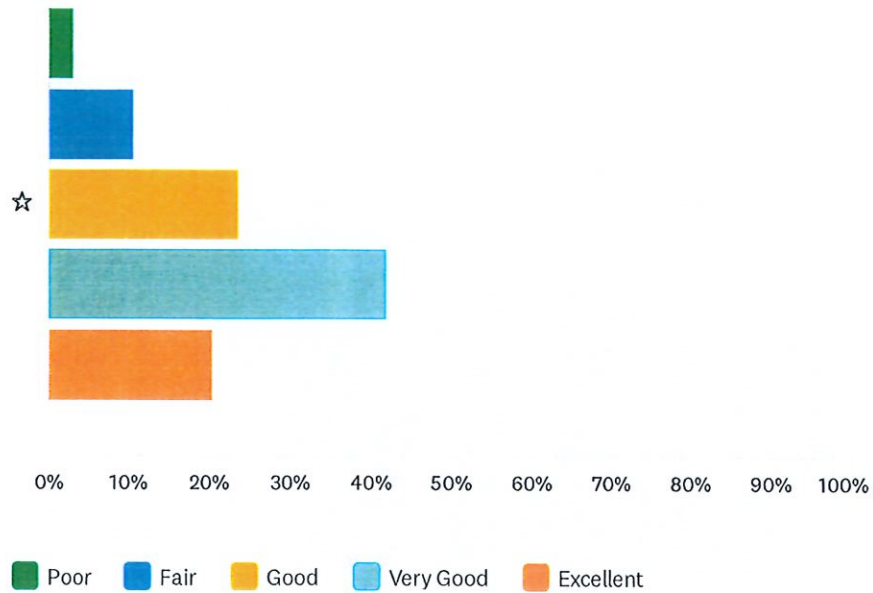


Q1 How would you rate your community as a place for people to live as they age? (This would be the geographical location where your home is located. A community can be located within a city or town or county.)

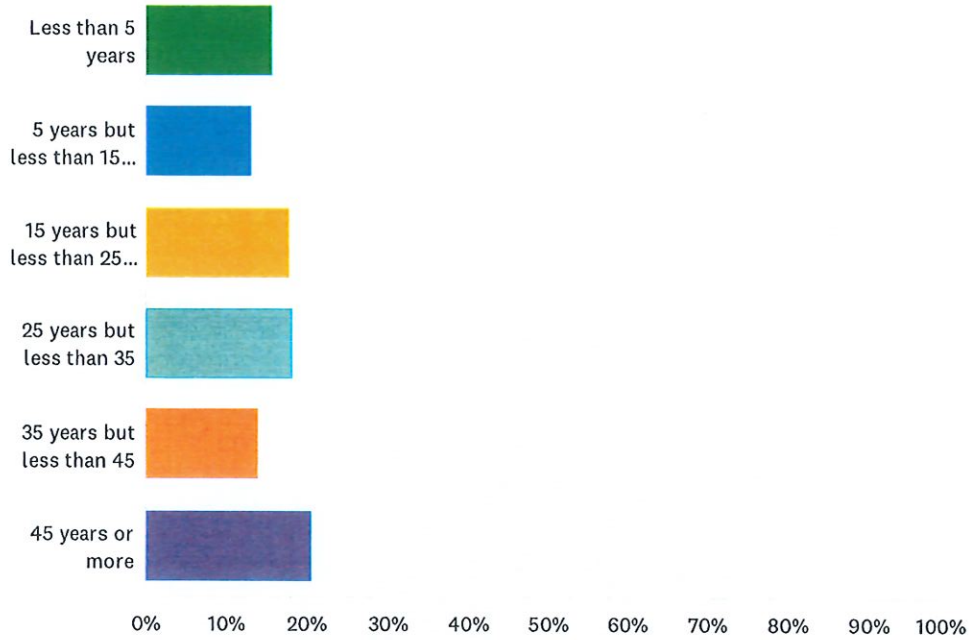

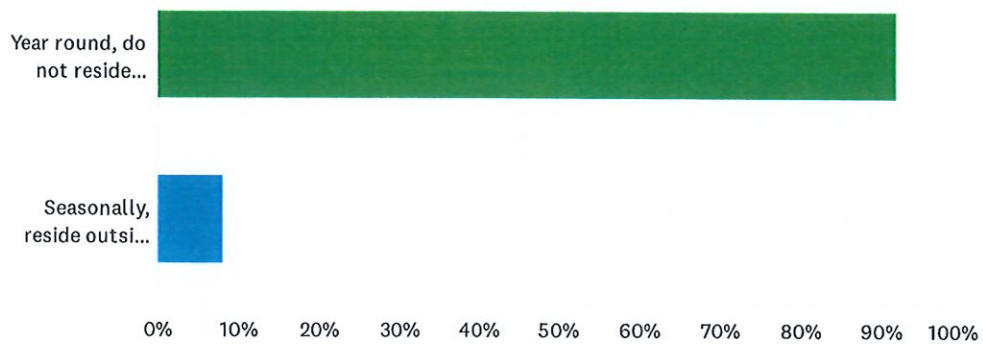

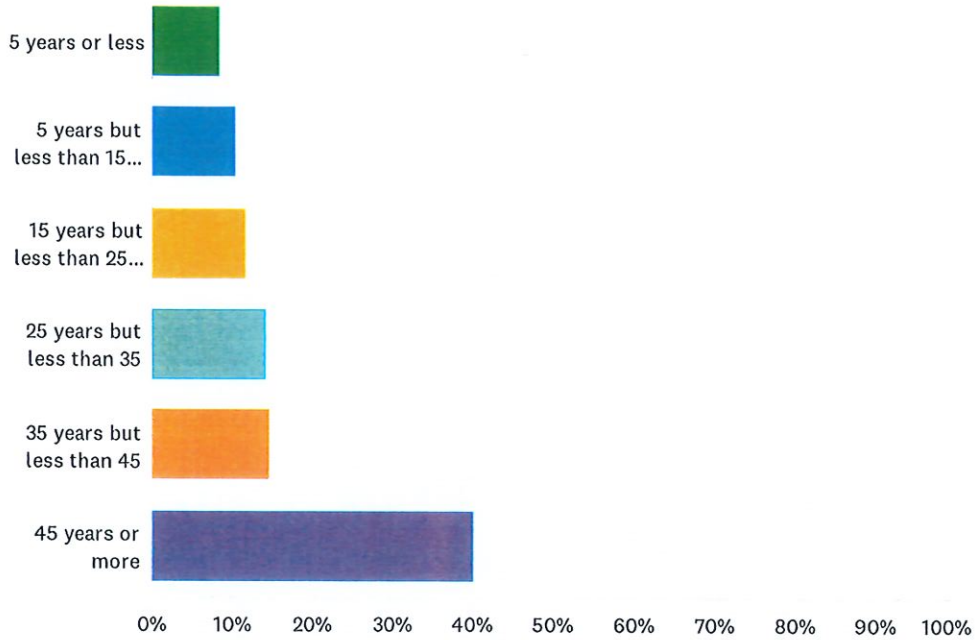

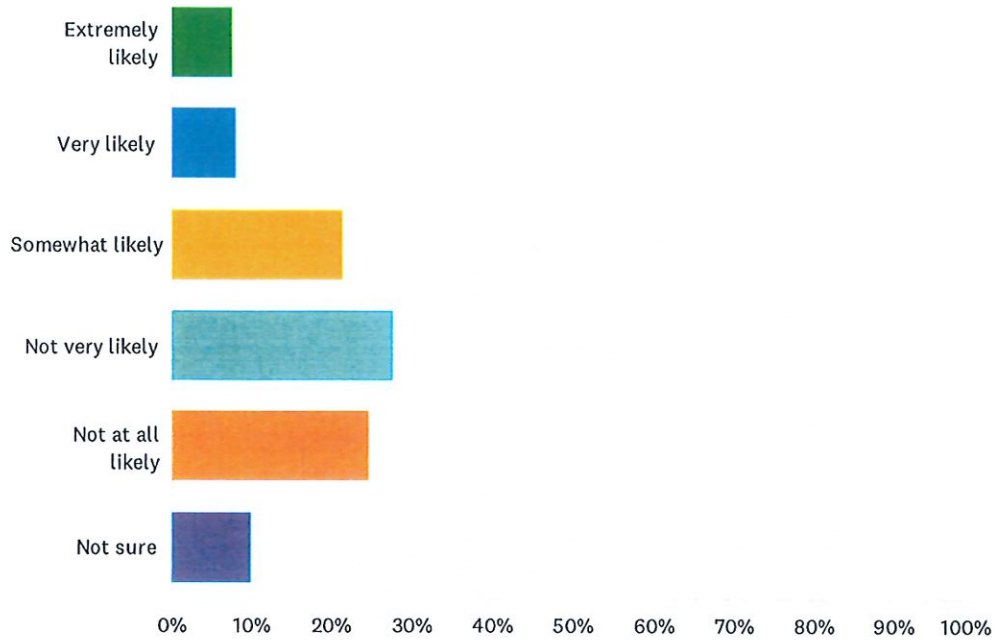

Q7 Thinking about your retirement years when you do not work at all for pay, how likely is it that you will move to a different home in your community?

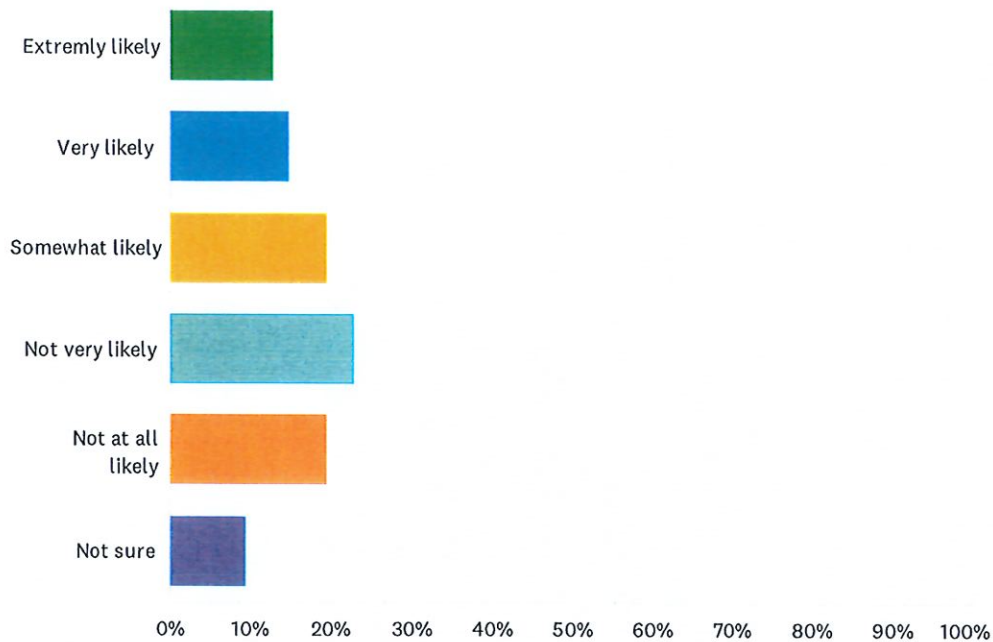

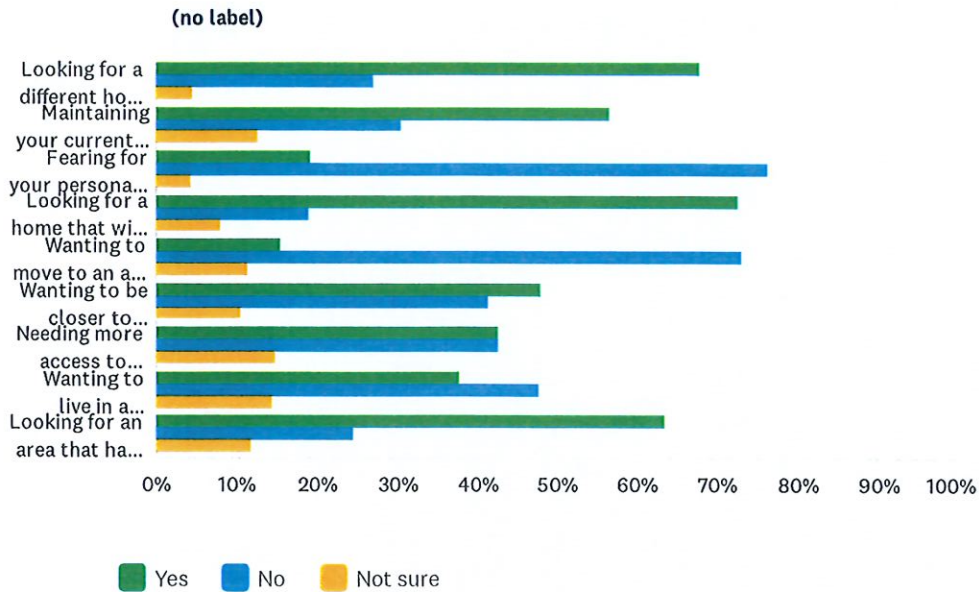

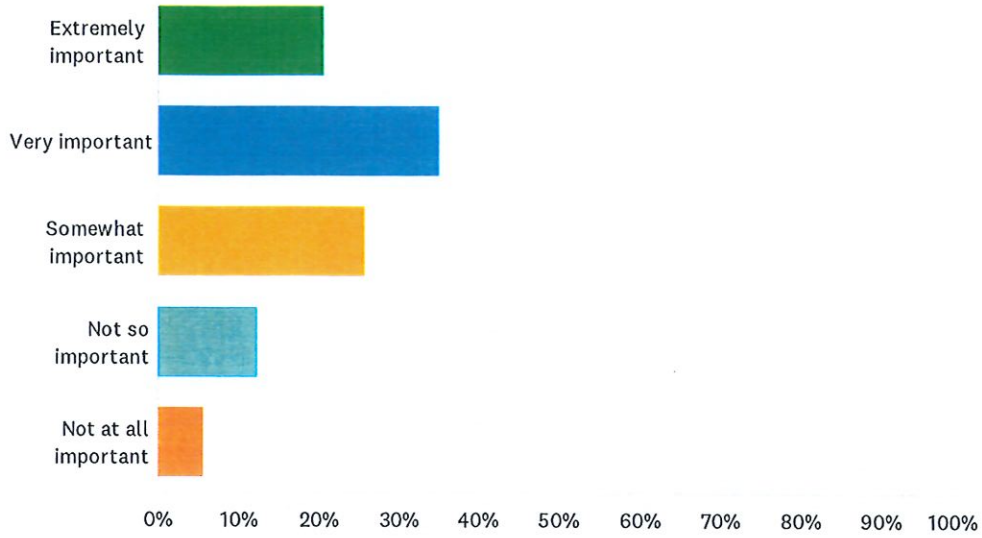

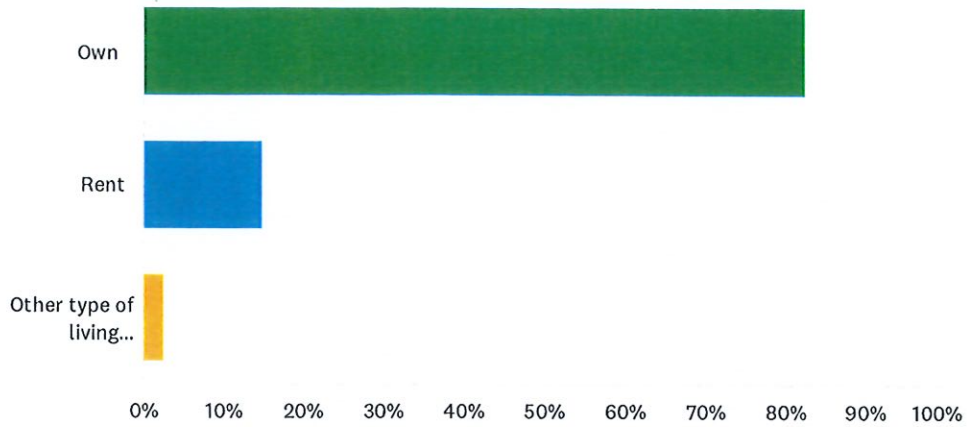

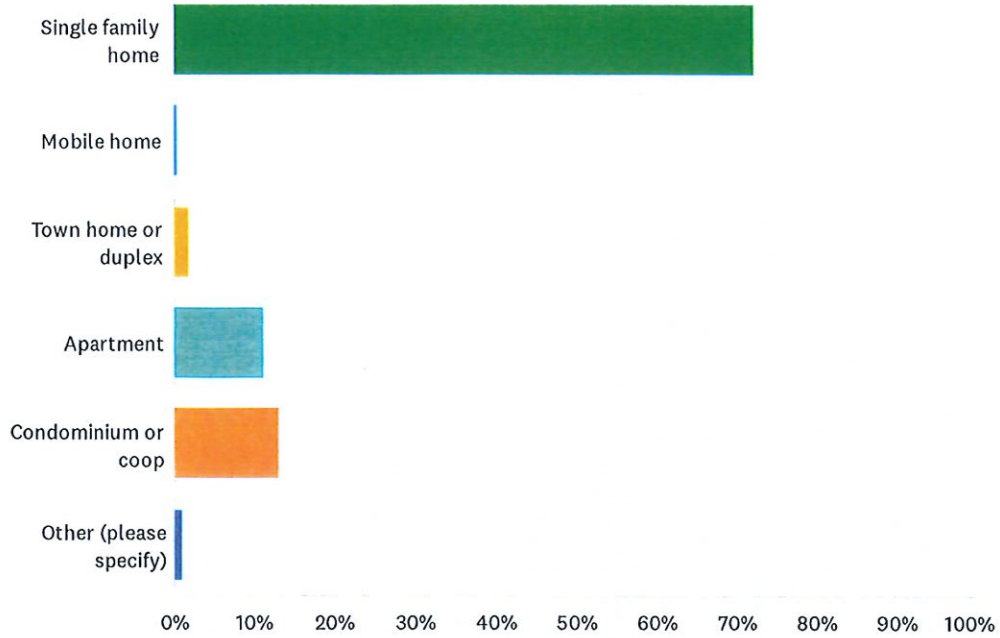

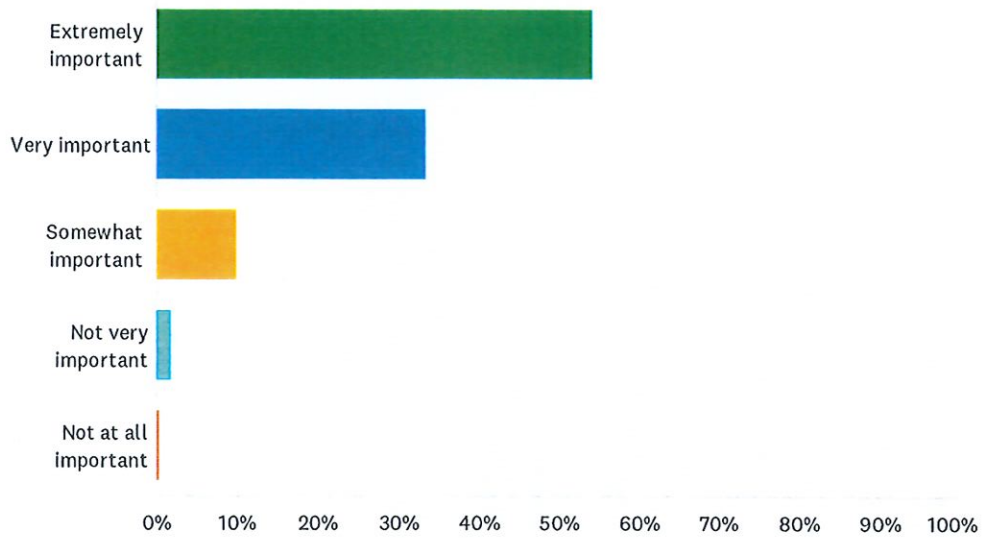

Q13 How important is it for you to be able to live independently in your own home as you age?

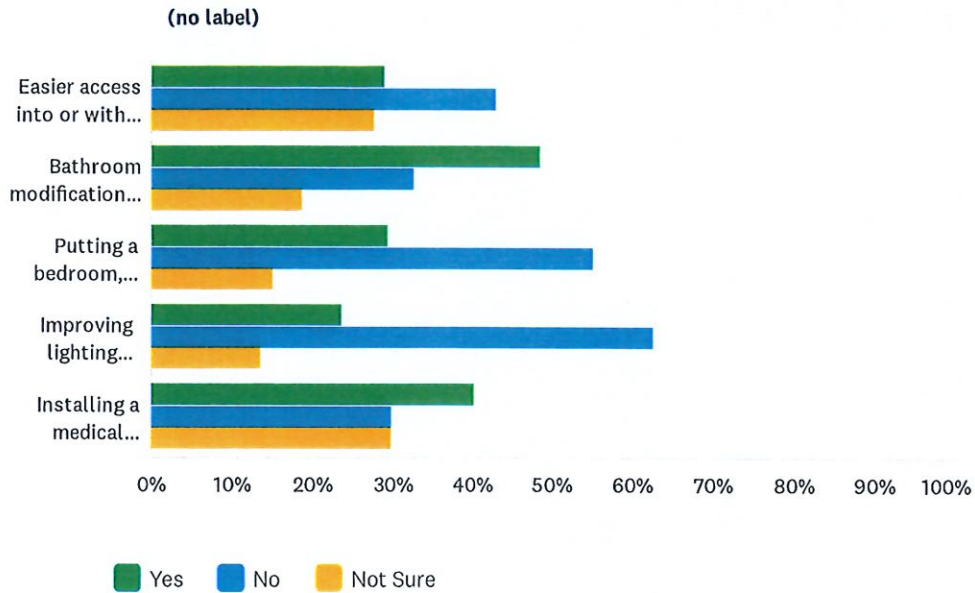

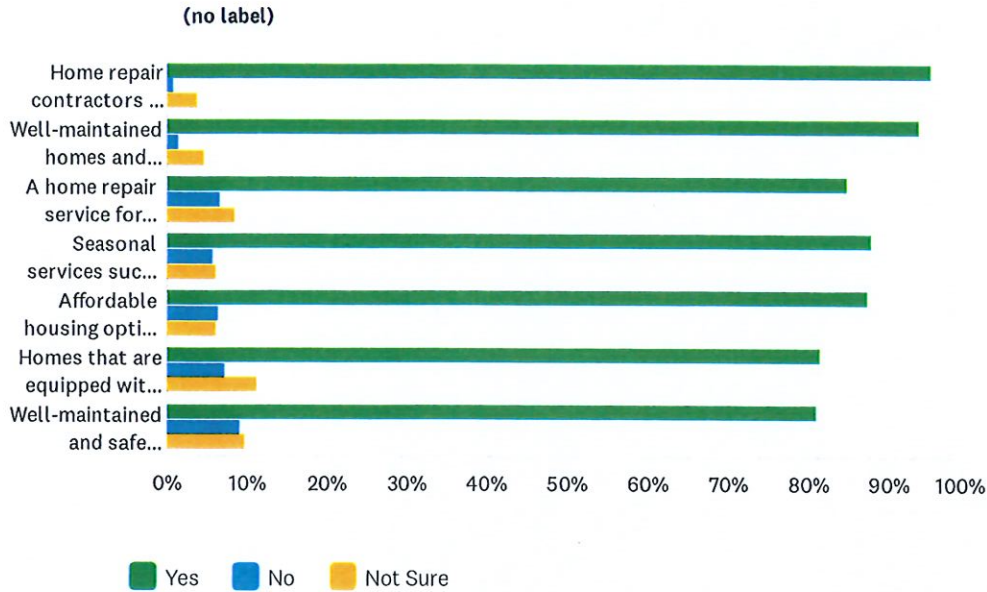

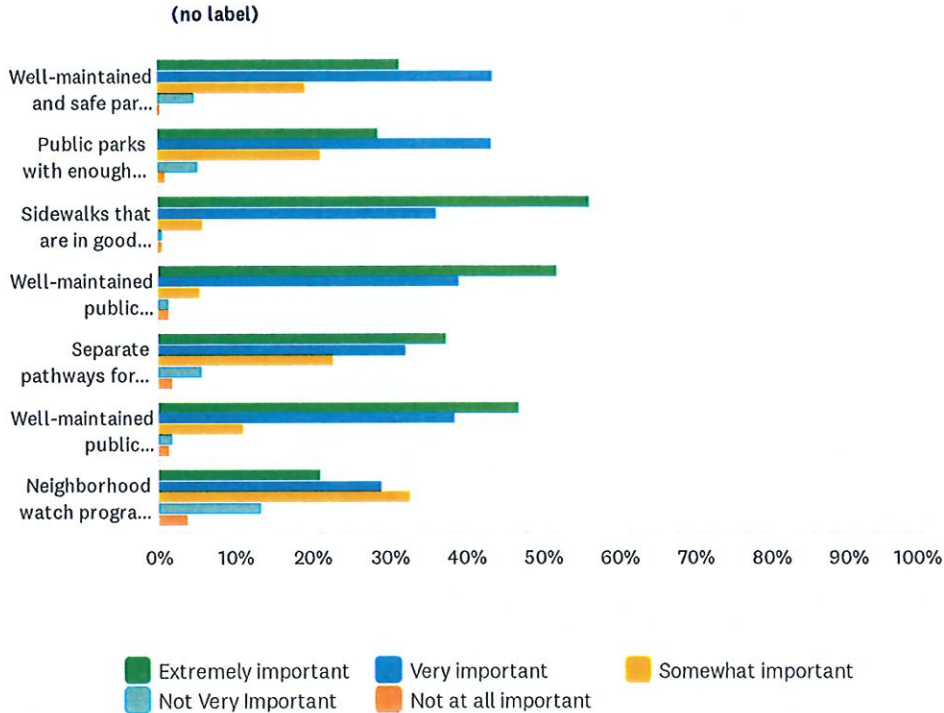

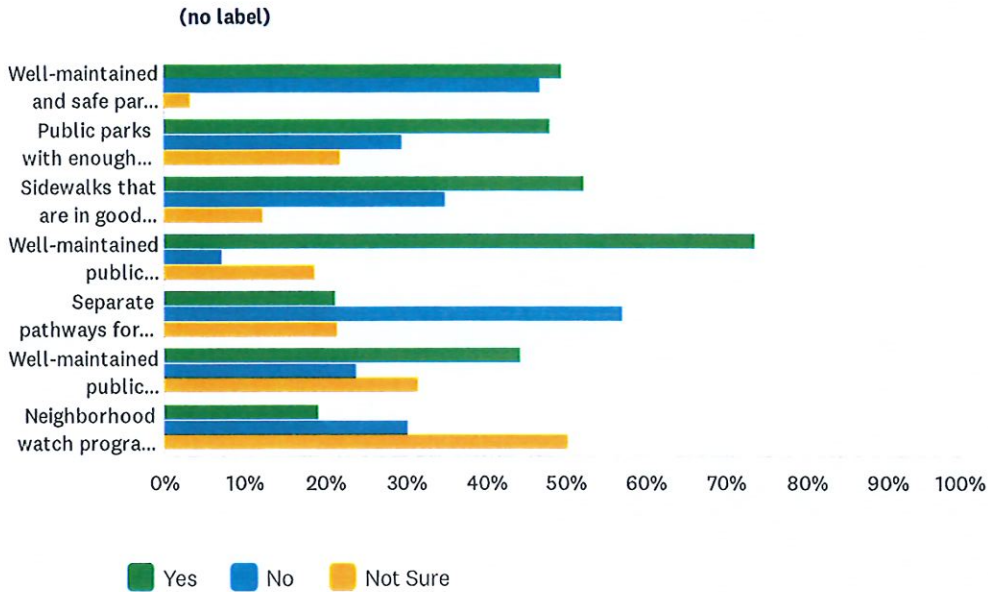

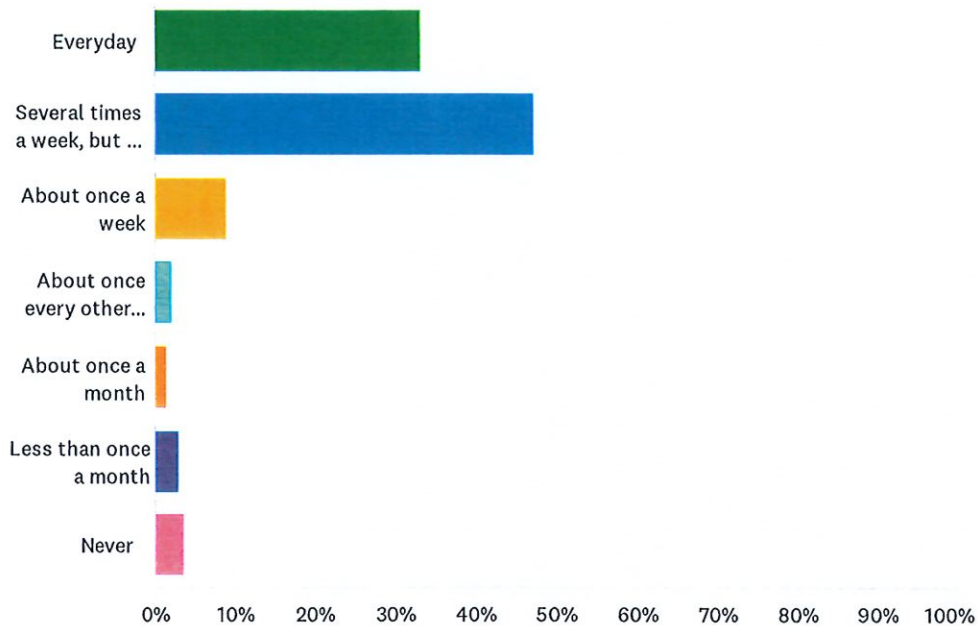

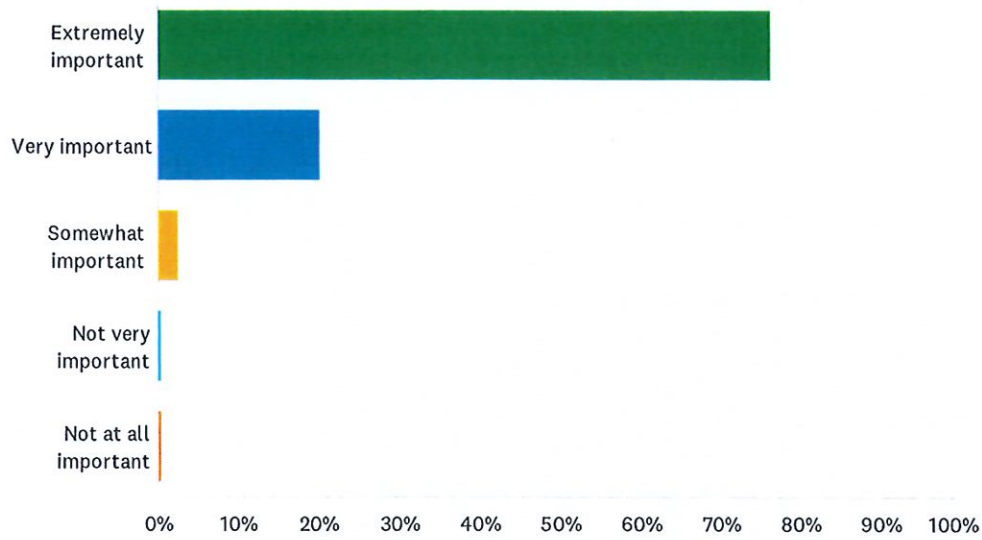

Q24 How important is it to you to remain physically active for as long as possible?

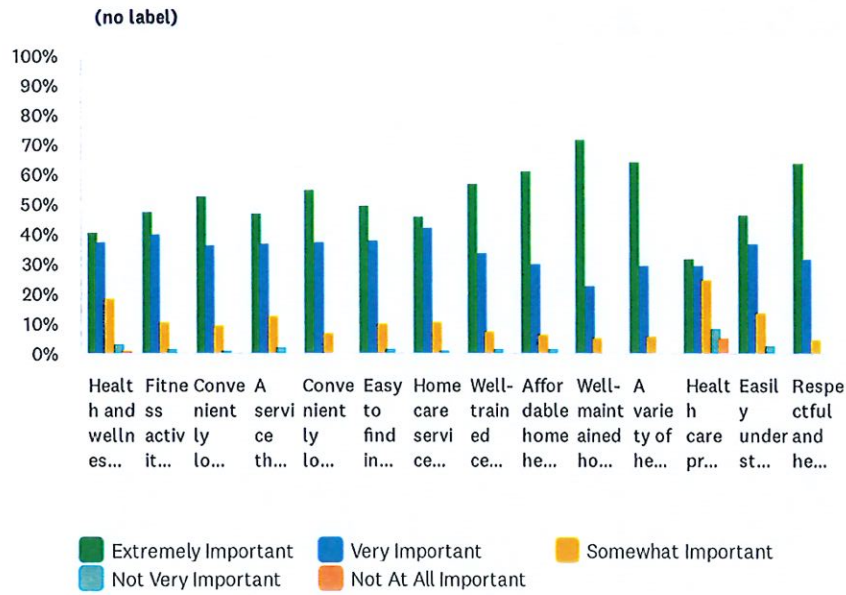

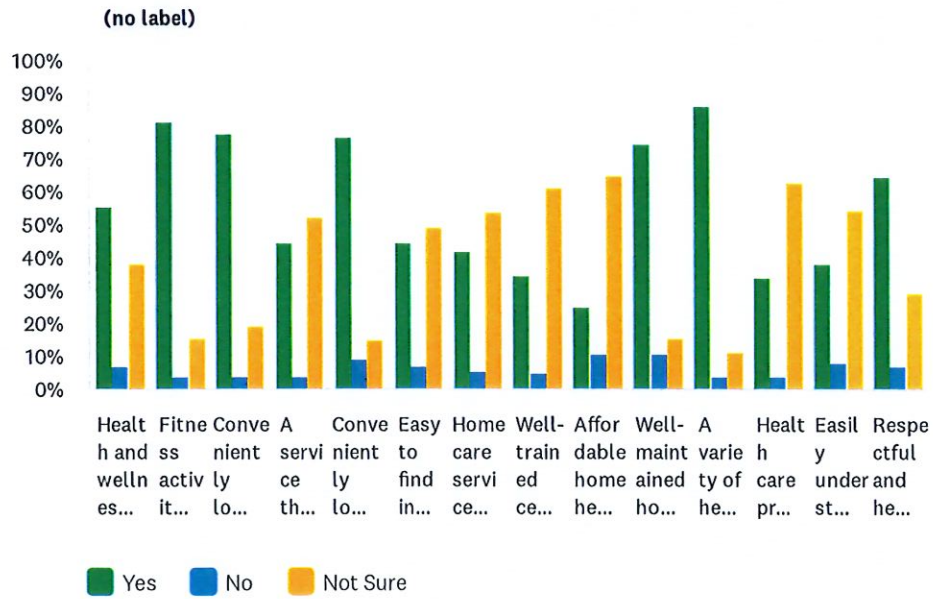

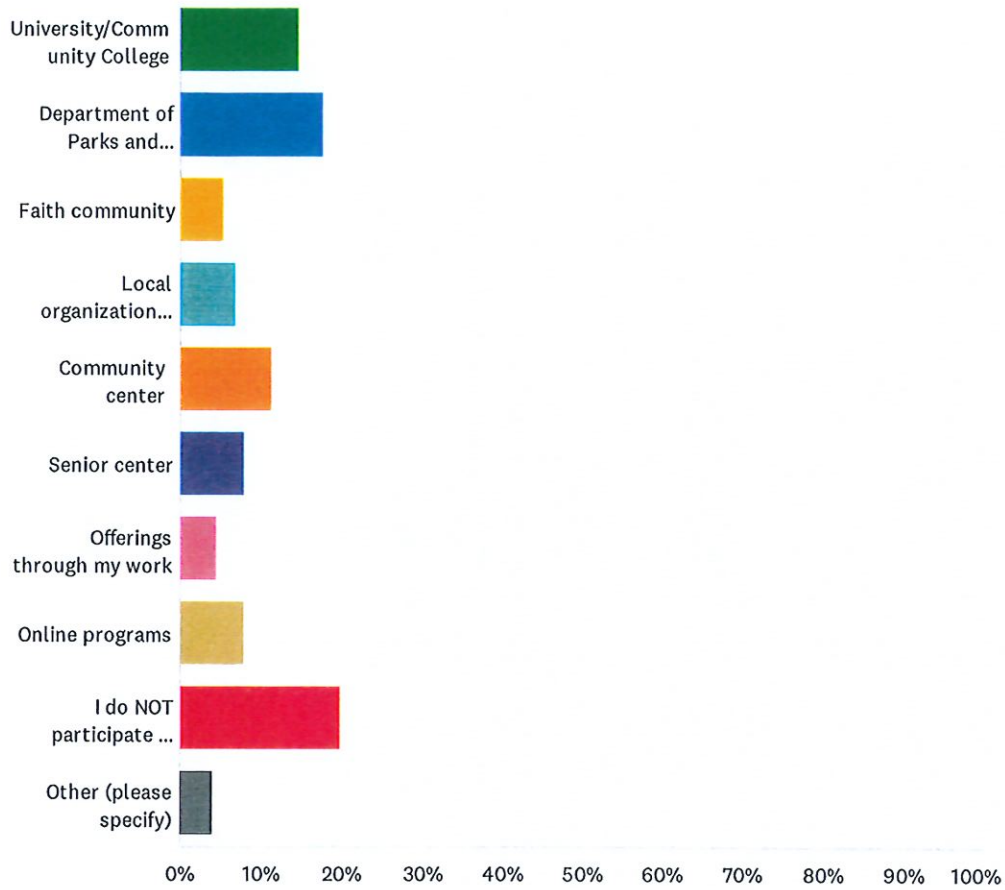

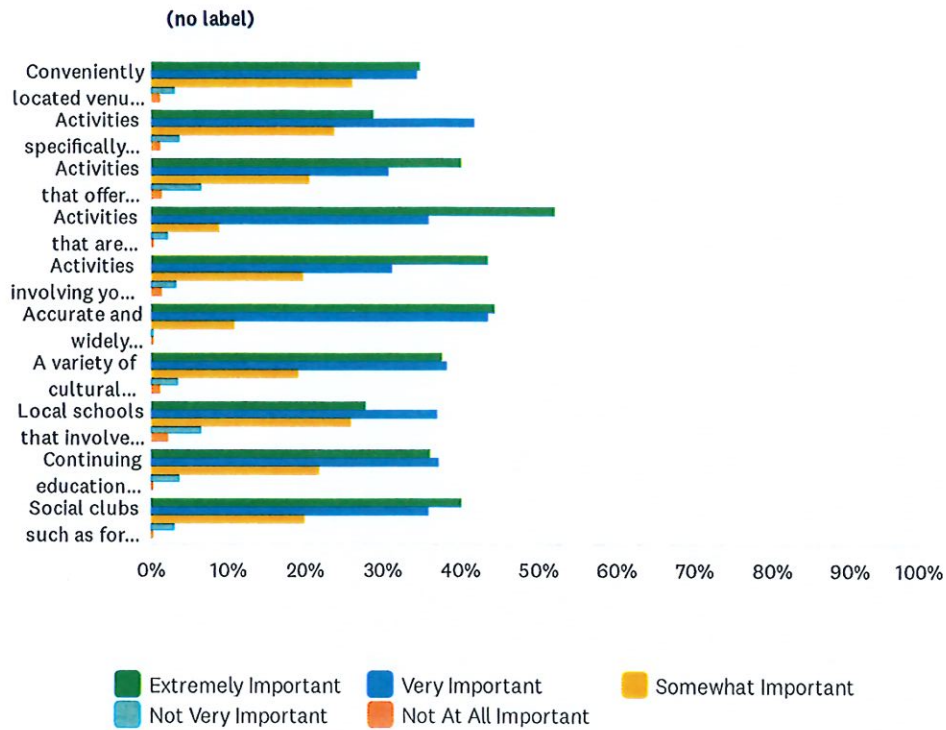

Q34 How likely is it that you will continue to work for as long as possible, rather than choosing to retire and no longer work for pay?

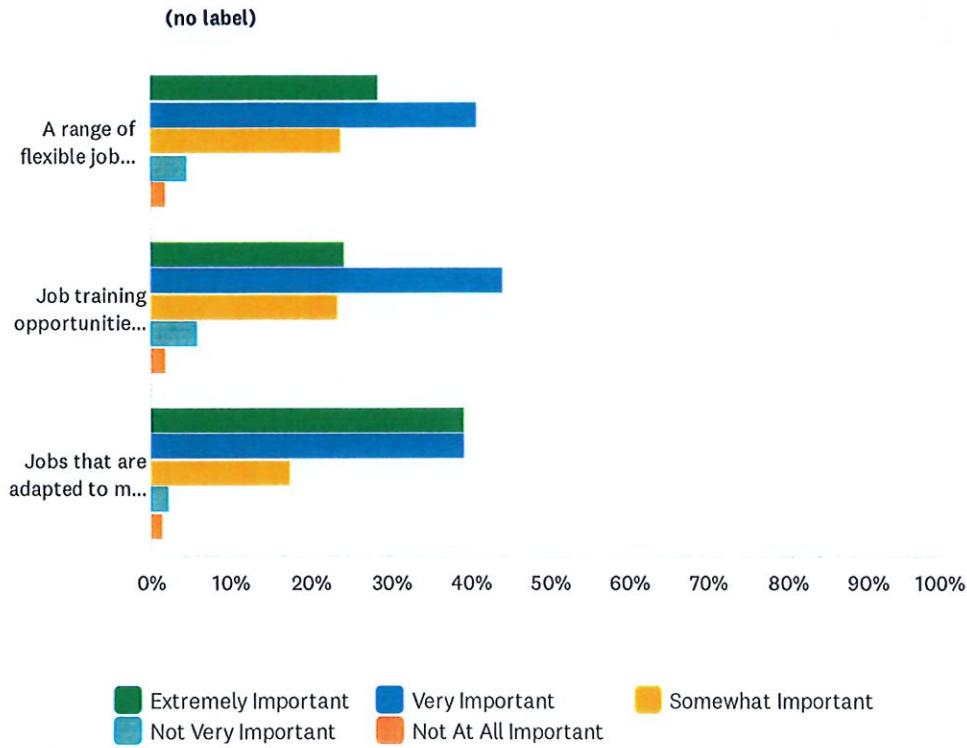

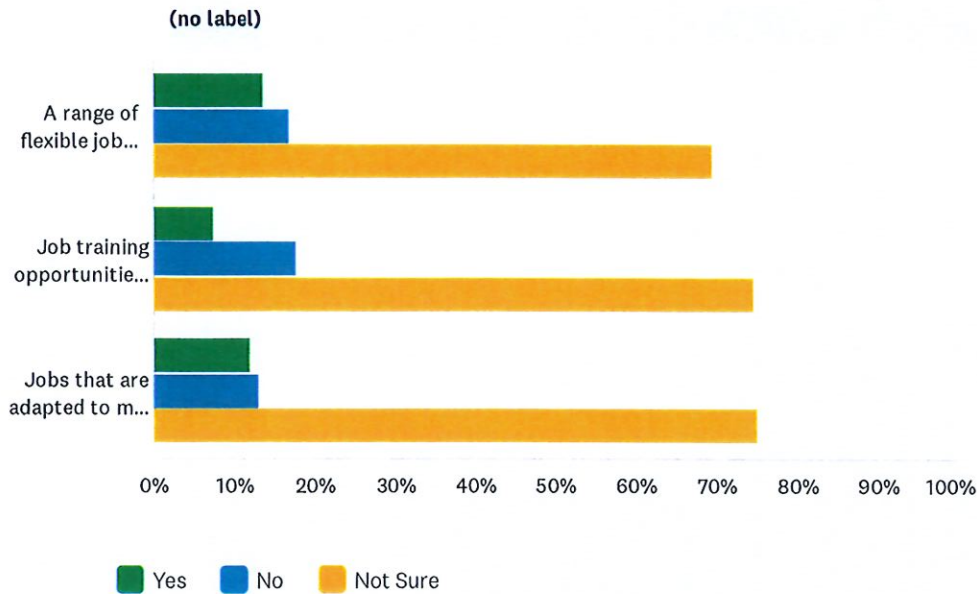

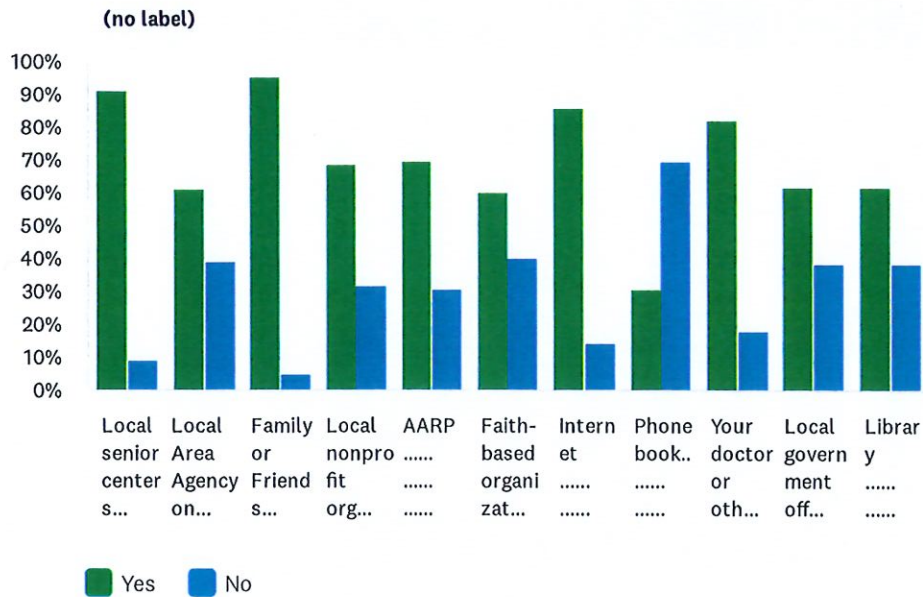

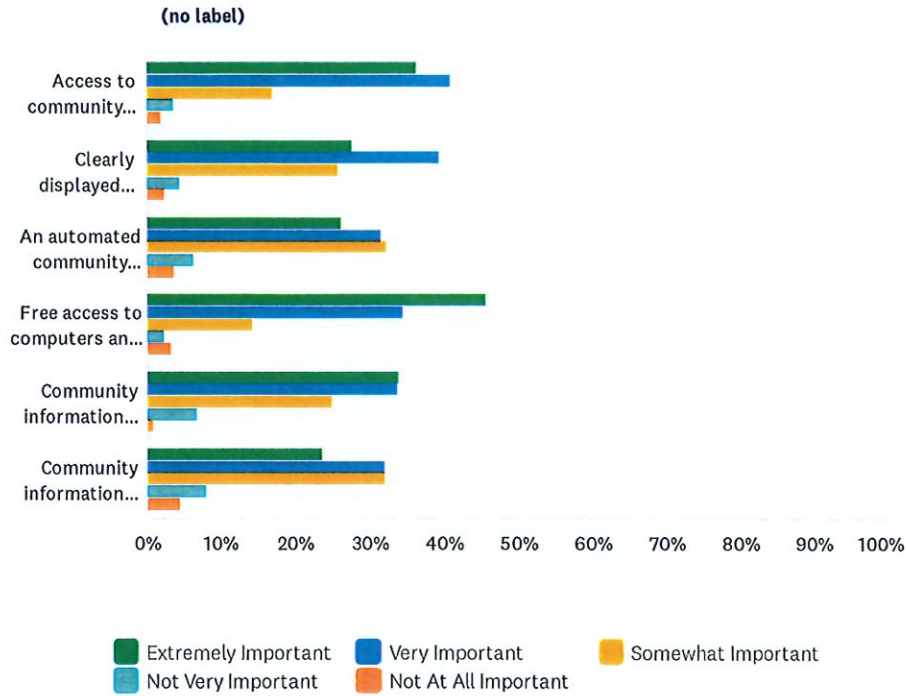

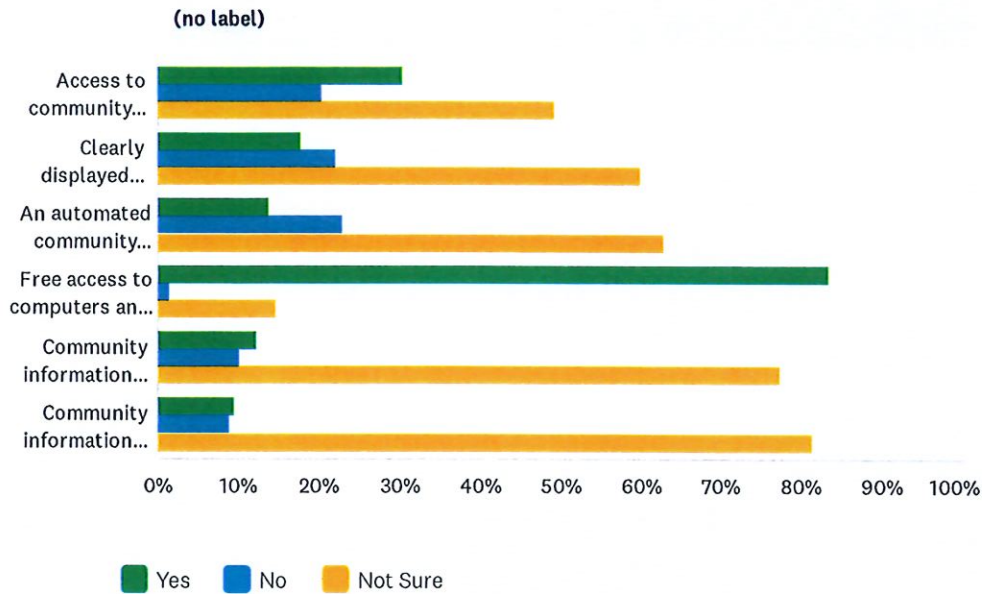
