



Q7 Thinking about your retirement years when you do not work at all for pay, how likely is it that you will move to a different home in your community?



Q8 Thinking about your retirement years when you do not work for pay, how likely is it that you will move to a different home outside of your community?



Q34 How likely is it that you will continue to work for as long as possible, rather than choosing to retire and no longer work for pay?



Q35 How important do you think it is to have the following in your community?







Q38 How important do you think it is to have the following in your community?


