Attendees walked east to west behind units 437 East Carriage Drive to 33 Montauk Way along the conservation easement.

The general boundary of the conservation easement was noted.

The trees the East Carriage Condo Association requests to cut were identified with orange flagging.

Commission members inquired of any written report from the East Carriage Condo Association regarding the health of the trees requested to be cut.

Drainpipes were observed within the conservation easement, some with stone lined channels. It was observed that the drainpipes served to discharge from the roof leaders.

The area of the approved rain garden was identified.
