SUBJECT: PRE-ALERT

Section I – Introduction

Objective.

To advise members of either a pending dispatch to an incident or a Department message prior to activation of the alert tones.

Applicability

This guideline applies to all fire related incidents or department messages.

Section II - Guidelines

A pre-alert message will be used to announce a pending emergency incident or message prior to the activation of the fire department alert tones. The fire department recognizes that Computer-Aided Dispatch is a process of entering data and then marrying the call nature to the incident location. This process takes time, therefore the pre-alert will enhance the fire department response time.

The dispatcher will pre-alert fire department personnel upon having sufficient information of an incident.
