SUBJECT: ASSIGNMENT MODIFICATION

### Section 1 – Introduction

## A. Objective

To provide a mechanism for an Officer to adjust the recommended response level either up or down.

## B. Applicability

Department Officers may modify an initial CAD recommended response utilizing the procedural sequence within this guideline.

## Section II - Guideline

Once the Dispatcher has dispatched the CAD recommended response for any given incident, an Officer may <u>upgrade</u> (assign additional resources) or <u>downgrade</u> (assign fewer resources) then what the CAD recommended immediately following the dispatch for good and just cause.

An Officer may upgrade or downgrade while en-route or on scene of an incident as additional information is received or as the situation is handled.

# WHO MAY ADJUST CAD RECOMMENDED RESPONSES

Level-1 incidents where the highest ranking company Officer responding can make an adjustment to the level of response.

Level-2 incidents where a Department's Chief Officer is responding and is responsible for any modification to the initial assignment.

#### WHEN TO ADJUST RECOMMENDED RESPONSES

For modifications immediately following dispatch, the Officer shall attempt to advise Fire Dispatch prior to the end of tone-out.

For modifications while en-route or while on scene the Officer shall advise of the need to upgrade or downgrade.

## HOW TO ADJUST RECOMMENDED RESPONSES

The Officer modifying an assignment should be specific for downgrades. Example:

CORRECT:

Fire Dispatch - Engine 11 only for this assignment

Fire Dispatch - Holding Engine 11; dismissing the remainder

NOT:

Fire Dispatch - Taking fire due only

Fire Dispatch - Holding the fire due, dismissing the remainder

The Officer upgrading an assignment may use normal terminology:

CORRECT:

Fire Dispatch - Send me the third due company or fire dispatch add Tanker 34 to the

assignment
