SUBJECT: INTRODUCTION

Section I – Introduction

A. Objective

The National Incident Management System (NIMS) enhances Fire Fighter safety by providing a modular organizational structure that can be used at all incidents both emergency and non-emergency. Additional components of the Incident Command System (ICS) will include common terminology, integrated communications, unity of command, a unified command structure, consolidated incident action plans, a manageable span of control and designated incident facilities.

B. Applicability

Glastonbury Fire Department will utilize the National Incident Management System (NIMS) which contains the Incident Command System (ICS) on all responses.


Section I – General
