#### Section I - Introduction

## A. Objective

To identify the method and means for confirming that all members working at an incident are present and accounted for.

### B. Applicability

To be used by members of the Glastonbury Fire Department and those firefighters responding with mutual aid departments.

#### Section II - Policy

The Incident Commander will conduct Personnel Accountability Reports (PAR) as defined in this guideline.

#### GENERAL

Several accountability benchmarks are included in tactical operations. The Personnel Accountability Report (PAR) involves a *roll call* of personnel assigned to an incident. A PAR is a confirmation that all members assigned to crews are accounted for.

For a "Division" or "Operations" Officer a PAR is an accounting of all crew members assigned to them. For crews operating directly under Command it is a responsibility of Command to account for crews.

Reports of PAR should be conducted face to face within the division or crew whenever possible.

Example of PAR Report:

"Fire Attack" from Command; do you have PAR?"

"Command from Fire Attack1; we have PAR!" (Meaning all member of fire attack) crews are together

## GUIDELINE

A Personnel Accountability Report (PAR) shall be conducted at the following times:

- 1. For any individual crew reporting an all-clear from an assignment.
- 2. Any change from offensive to defensive operations; all members.
- 3. Following any hazardous event (flashover/backdraft/collapse); all members.
- 4. Following any "MAYDAY" or report of missing/trapped members, all members.
- 5. At each 30 minute interval or elapsed incident time; all members
- 6. At a formal transfer of Command; all members
- 7. At a report of "fire under control"; all members
