Section I - Introduction

A. Objective

The purpose of this guideline is to identity a method and a means to advise firefighters of the need to withdraw from a hostile environment.

B. Applicability

Withdraw shall be the acknowledged term to advise firefighters that a situation requires an orderly evacuation of themselves and their equipment from a structure or other hazardous environment.

Section II - Guideline

This transmission will indicate to all units, crews, and fire dispatcher that an Incident Commander or Safety Officer has determined that all operating personnel shall withdraw themselves and their equipment from interior assignment. The acceptable transmission from Command shall be (example: "All units operating on Main Street are advised to Withdraw".) The message will then be repeated by Command.

Following Withdraw, a complete PAR will be conducted to assure accountability.
