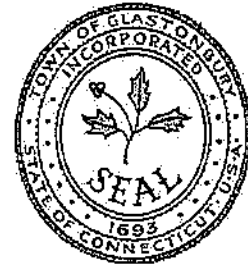

Section II – Guideline

Glastonbury provides mutual-aid to East Hartford as defined in this guideline.

**SINGLE UNIT RESPONSE**

Station 1's fire apparatus of the proper type shall be dispatched to mutual-aid calls. The apparatus shall be staffed with a minimum of three (3) interior certified firefighters one of which would preferably be an Officer. A support member, certified to drive the particular apparatus assigned, may response on the mutual-aid assignment, as well.

A Chief Officer shall respond to incidents where the apparatus has been requested directly to the scene. Either a Captain or Lieutenant shall be assigned for incidents where the apparatus has been requested for station coverage.
