



URANIUM IN DRINKING WATER

- Naturally occurring
- EPA Drinking Water Standard = 30 ug/L
- CTDPH recommends don't drink or bathe > 900 ug/L




WATER SYSTEM EXPANSION STUDY AREAS



CHESTNUT HILL ROAD AREA (MDC)


- Pink served from New London Tpke
- Green served from Coleman Road
- Grey served from Lakewood Road
- No service around Knob Hill Rd. and Wood Pond Rd.
- No MDC system improvements


- Uplands HS WL (HGL 540)

- Potential new tank




Proposed Water Main

CONCEPTUAL COSTS

Manchester Water Main (~242 lots)	24,503 ft	\$500/ft	\$12,251,500
Manchester Pump Station Upgrade	1	LS	\$200,000
Manchester New Pump Station	1	LS	\$1,000,000
Manchester Tank			
Total:	89,433 ft 16.9 miles		\$46 million

Costs Exclude:

- Property acquisition for pump station or storage tank
- Service lines from property line to home
- Well abandonments

SYSTEM EXPANSION PROCESS (MDC)

Petition Process

- 1. Homeowner Petition
- 2. MDC Study
- 3. Public Hearing
- 4. MDC Commissioners' Decision
- 5. Homeowner Assessments
 - \$95/front-foot
 - Service line to property
 - 15 years @ 6%
- 6. Actual cost true-up paid by existing Glastonbury customers

Developers Permit Agreement


Expansion designed, constructed and paid for by "developer"

SYSTEM EXPANSION PROCESS (MANCHESTER)

- Expansion designed, constructed and paid for by "developer".
 - Manchester may take on design and construction at "developer's" expense
 - No assessment method

AAC A STUDY OF MUNICIPALITIES AND HOMEOWNERS WITH WELL CONTAMINATED WITH URANIUM

- SB 1065: Planning & Development Committee
- Requires DPH and OPM to study municipalities with Uranium
 - Levels of Uranium in groundwater
 - Number of private wells affected by Uranium
 - Available resources to assist homeowners with impacted wells
- Report by January 1, 2022
 - Findings of above study
 - Recommendations for legislation to address concerns including
 - Grants, low interest loans and other forms of financial assistance to municipalities and homeowners
