Prevention Update

Mirela Mujcinovic discussed recent opioid settlement which resulted in \$16,000 in funding to YFS; discussed the rise in drug overdoses due to fentanyl and other lethal drugs such as xylazine; discussed potential initiatives targeted at youth and parents to raise awareness of these dangers; appealed to Commission to help reach out/promote initiatives to community members. Informed commission of the 10/29 National Drug Take Back event in Glastonbury.

YFS Summer Programs

Lori LaCapra updated the commission on summer programming-participants in the Welles Village
Activities for Youth (WACY) program and the summer musical production have bounced back and
programming is returning to pre-pandemic formats

YFS Staffing

 Discussed staffing needs given continued increase in clinical referrals and escalating needs; recruiting qualified applicants has been challenging as remote jobs, higher pay state positions, and private practice options are reducing interest in community based, in-person positions. Need to explore part time and contracted positions and widen recruitment efforts

Future Programming

 Discussed bringing back Peer Mediation at the middle school level, Parenting Education Forums and Support Groups, Community Conversations/Public Forums with students, parents, and community members to discuss "Keeping Kids Safe; increase partnering with stake holders in town such as Rotary Club, Boys Scouts, Glastonbury Public Schools, Glastonbury Police Department and the Interfaith Community Group
