TITLE: Music & Arts Camp Teacher

DEPARTMENT: Parks and Recreation REPORTS TO: Music & Arts Camp Director

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Incumbent plans, implements and evaluates a curriculum in their assigned subject area. Incumbent supervises program participants.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Supervises program participants and is responsible for the safety, accounting and discipline of children in their class.
- 2. Plans, prepares, implements and evaluates assigned subject areas.
- 3. Completes required year-end paperwork including evaluation, recommendations, lesson plans and orders.
- 4. Communicates effectively with all camp staff, directors, and campers.
- 5. Regularly attends and is punctual for work.
- 6. Attends staff meetings and final performance.
- 7. Adheres to and enforces all established Town and Department policies and procedures; maintains confidentiality of records and information as appropriate.
- 8. Observes safe work and play practices.
- 9. Represents the Town in a professional and Courteous manner at all times.

OTHER JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Assists with the set-up and break-down of camp site.
- 2. Performs related work as required.

QUALIFICATIONS PROFILE:

- Considerable knowledge of subject area and classroom management.
- Ability to lead an activity
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions and to learn Town procedures. Ability to communicate orally and
 in writing in a clear, concise, and persuasive manner. Ability to read and interpret plans and procedures
- Ability to fill out forms and charts, perform basic arithmetic, and prepare reports and records
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with campers, co-workers, colleagues, and the public
- Ability to oversee the work of others

PHYSICAL/MENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to lift objects weighing up to 25 lbs. Must be mobile and able to sit and/or stand for prolonged periods
 of time. Able to perform skills which require hand-eye coordination such as using a computer
- Ability to see objects far away as in driving; see objects closely as in reading a report; and discriminate colors.
 Ability to hear normal sounds with some background noise and able to distinguish sound as voice patterns.
 Ability to communicate through human speech
- Ability to concentrate on fine detail with some interruption. Needs to attend to task/function for 25-45 minutes
 at a time. Ability to understand and relate to specific ideas, generally several at a time, and to understand and
 relate to theories behind several related concepts. Able to remember task/assignment given at beginning of a
 period of time extending several days and over long periods of time
- Ability to work professionally with co-workers, supervisors, customers and the public at large. Exposure to high and low temperatures and conditions in outside weather; exposure to radiation (UV sunlight)

MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

- Graduation from college or university with a bachelor's degree in Education, Art, Music, Drama, Dance or related field.
