  - ✓ Is comprised of questions dealing with administration and operations, human and group behavior, constitutional law, ethics, personnel management and supervision, and inmate management and supervision
  - ✓ Passing score is 70% and represents 50% of your total score
  - ✓ See attached Reading List
- Oral Panel Exam TBD -Town Hall Meeting Room A 9:00-4:30 pm (candidates will be notified of their .45 minute time slot by email).
  - ✓ A panel of public safety professionals will ask a series of questions designed to offer you the ability to display your police management knowledge and acumen
  - ✓ In preparation, candidates should be familiar with The Connecticut Law Enforcement Officers' Field Manual (AKA The Original Red Book), and Department General Orders
  - ✓ Passing score is 70% and represents 50% of your total score
  - ✓ Accepted attire: Class B uniform of the day
- Interview WHEN & WHERE: <u>To be announced</u>
  - ✓ Chief Porter will interview the three (3) highest (total) scoring candidates plus one (1) for each additional vacancy and submit promotional recommendations to the Town Manager
