School Access	Sidewalk connection is in the vicinity of a school and will improve pedestrian access to the property.
School Bus Route	More efficient school bus routing can be achieved by completing the proposed sidewalk connection.

Special Needs	Sidewalk connection will improve access to facilities with a large population of elderly, handi-capped,
Community Area	or other special needs persons.
Town Center or	Sidewalk connection will extend the Town Center sidewalk network or the network surrounding other
other Commercial	commercial areas.

Access to Town	Access to a Town Park or other Town facility will be provided by the proposed sidewalk connection.

Town Facility	
Regional	A connection between two regional sidewalk networks is achieved through the proposed sidewalk
Sidewalk Network	project.
Connection	
Heavy	Sidewalk connection is proposed along a route where heavy pedestrian use for recreational
Recreational Use	purposes has been noted.
Area	
Heavy Pedestrian	Heavy pedestrian usage of proposed sidewalk area is currently noted, usually based on worn path
Traffic Area	evident along edge of roadway.
Arterial Roadway	Road is classified as a Town or State arterial indicating higher traffic volumes and higher speeds.
(ADT > 3000  vpd)	
Special Safety	Sidewalk connection is in an area of particular safety concern for pedestrians, including high vehicle
Concern Area	speeds, limited sight line, narrow road, lack of shoulders, etc.
