1. Election of Officer

A. Vice Chairman

Mr. Davis nominated Brian Comerford for Vice Chairman of the Water Pollution Control Authority and Mr. Campbell seconded the nomination.

Mr. Campbell **MOVED** to approve Brian Comerford for Vice Chairman of the Water Pollution Control Authority.

Mr. Horvath SECONDED the MOTION and the motion was **APPROVED** unanimously.

3. Subcommittees

A. Sewer Use Subcommittee

- 1. Subcommittee Recommendation- 2023 Sewer Use Rates**
 - a. Set Public Hearing Date: October 11, 2023**

The Subcommittee explained justification for the .10 cents/ccf, \$15 minimum bill and \$10 deduction meter reading increases for 2023 sewer use rates. Mr. Davis added that the surcharge and minimum bill have remained unchanged since 2009.

Mr. Campbell **MOVED**, that the Town of Glastonbury Water Pollution Control Authority **ACCEPT** the recommendation of the Sewer Use Subcommittee – 2023 Sewer Use Rates.

Mr. Comerford **SECONDED** the **MOTION** and it was **APPROVED** unanimously.

B. Assessment Subcommittee

C. Engineering Subcommittee

Mr. Manfre noted that Weston & Sampson data collection at the Parker Terrace pump station is still in progress. He also discussed a future RFP to perform CIP Lining project beginning in areas of old vitrified clay pipe identified on Figure 6-6 – Sanitary Sewer Criticality Assessment–Age within

the current Sanitary Sewer Master Plan. Mr. Mahoney clarified how the CIP Lining process is completed. Mr. Manfre explained target areas for the next five to ten years.
