As part of our everyday effort to deliver dependable energy to our customers and communities, we are preparing to perform field surveys and cultural resource assessments and replace existing substation equipment and hardware with new, more reliable equipment at the Hopewell 22R Substation located on Eversource property off Chestnut Hill Road in Glastonbury. Maintaining the infrastructure that supports the electric lines is one of the ways Eversource ensures the safe, secure transmission of electricity throughout the region.

We are Always Working to Serve You Better

You're receiving this letter because project work will occur within the Substation near your property. This project, called the Hopewell 22R Transformer Replacements Project, includes the replacement of the existing transformer and associated devices with new, more reliable equipment. All work for this project will take place on Eversource-owned property on Chestnut Hill Road in Glastonbury.

What You Can Expect

First, we want you to know that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property and that all people working on this Project will carry identification.

Pending all the necessary approvals, construction for this project is expected to begin in November of 2023. All construction activities and restoration will be completed by Summer of 2024. We will keep the lines of communication open and communicate with you throughout the project approval phase and will provide you updates on the Project schedule.
