The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of the project is to implement signing and pavement marking improvements at unsignalized municipally owned and maintained intersections as needed to improve visibility and compliance. This project will replace existing stop signs, double yellow centerlines, and stop bars as well as introduce oversized stop signs and stop ahead and intersection ahead warning signs.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed project are not anticipated.

Construction is anticipated to begin Fall 2025 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$2,580,000. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 100% federal funds.
