On Saturday, September 28, 2024, at approximately 11:50 HRS, members of the Glastonbury Police Department responded to an attempted robbery in the parking lot of Stop and Shop at 215 Glastonbury Boulevard.

Preliminary investigation revealed several individuals arrived at the grocery store in a stolen vehicle just before noon. The suspects attempted a gun-point robbery of a female entering her vehicle after shopping. The victim fled her vehicle and did not sustain injuries. No property was stolen. The robbery attempt appears to be part of a pattern of similar robberies occurring throughout the state.

The attempted robbery is an active and ongoing investigation. No additional details or images will be released at this time.

The case is being investigated by Officer Barrett of the Glastonbury Police Department Investigations Division.
