We started our professional journey in the New Britain Artists Co-op, working besides Adrian Elliot on several community projects, including live art, gallery shows, as well as public art.


Our team in recent years has completed large scale murals throughout NYC Public Schools, and is highly experienced in working with challenging substrates and in just about every imaginable creative venture.

Project Background

The designs presented are intended to be installed directly on the wall. We will use plastic sheeting and drop cloths to prevent overspray to passerby's. We will use UV-resistant artists quality spray paint and exterior latex paint with brushes to achieve vibrant colors and complete lasting coverage on the wall. We use a trusted process to produce lasting pieces of public art, which has been successful in many other recently completed jobs throughout Connecticut and New York City.

We understand this is intended to be a community mural, and have designed this wall with community involvement in mind. We would use traditional outdoor paint for this process to ensure safety of all participants, and can incorporate stencils elements to produce a cohesive look with the rest of the mural.

The impact of this mural will be significant not only as a way to beautify a prominent public space, but also encourage cultural tourism and economic activity in the area to existing businesses in the plaza. The hope that this will be a source of inspiration and a catalyst for conversations about the role of the arts, and "pizza with possibilities" amongst all who engage in our wonderful Glastonbury community.

Proposed Artwork




- Relatable universal theme, inspiring for all ages, personifies business motto "Pizza with Possibilities"




- Proposal features easy to complete stencils similar to above images.
