ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Documentation Required

Household Assets - Proof of all liquid assets and their current value, i.e. checking and savings accounts, credit unions, CD's, stocks, bonds, and any other assets which can be converted to cash. NOTE: All household members over the age of 59½ must provide the current value of any 401K's or IRA's that they have. Bank statements or a letter from the bank can be used for verification.

- * If employed the four most recent pay stubs for each employed person in the household. If this is not available, a statement from the employer on company letterhead stating gross weekly wages for the past four weeks is required.
- * <u>Social Security Income</u> a copy of the check, bank statement or letter of award, showing the current benefit rate.
- * <u>Pension or Annuity Income</u> a copy of the check or letter from the former employer stating the current monthly gross income.
- * <u>Dividends and Interest</u> statements showing monthly amounts.
- * <u>Veteran's Benefits</u> award letter stating current gross benefit or a copy of the check.
- * Most recent Bank Statement
- * Gas bill a copy of your bill no more than 2 months old.
- * <u>Electric bill</u> a copy of your bill no more than 2 months old.
- * If you receive cash benefits from the state Bring that application and a copy of your current State Budget.

**** If heat is included in rent, client must bring a rent receipt.
