Grant Application

The Glastonbury Alcohol and Drug Council, more commonly known as GLAD, is a community coalition comprised of a wide assortment of individuals; including parents, representatives from community organizations, area businesses, faith groups, health professionals, town staff and youth. GLAD’S primary goals are to raise awareness regarding alcohol and drug use in our community, to foster a healthy community environment, to advocate for the enforcement of laws to prevent and/or reduce high risk behaviors involving alcohol, tobacco and other drug use, and to provide information to the community about resources aimed at the prevention of underage drinking and drug abuse.

The “Thank GLAD It’s Friday” mini-grants is an initiative developed for teen groups in our community to organize and implement a Friday evening drug and alcohol free activity at the Glastonbury Academy building. Funding must be used to support programs and events that are considered prevention and/or youth development, as well as those directed toward the mission of GLAD. These grants will be awarded up to \$500.00 for each organization and are open to teen youth serving groups in Glastonbury.

- In order to be selected, the event must be promoted as a drug and alcohol free event,
- Must serve a minimum of 15 to 20 teens, maximum attendance allowed will be 250 youth
- Applicant must provide appropriate adult supervision with a ratio of one adult to 25 youth
- All events will be held at the Glastonbury Academy Building
- Each grantee will be given support from the GLAD TGIF Coordinator to implement their drug and alcohol free activity.
- Each funded group will be required to have a planning meeting and will be required to invite the GLAD TGIF Coordinator to ensure compliance with grant requirements
- TGIF events are intended to raise awareness and promote healthy drug and alcohol free activities for Glastonbury teens, therefore events may not be used for fundraising purposes.
