outside of the face of the stone arch? Specifically Station 9+87 to 9+93 Right & Left and Station 10+10 R to 10+16 R and 10+10 L to 10+12 L. The vertical limits of removal of the spandrel wall are as required to construct the parapet A1-1: footing and curb base, so at a minimum it would be to the bottom of footing elevation for these items. This removal work is included under the lump sum item "Removal of Masonry". Additional spandrel wall stones that are bulging or loose and are below this elevation will need to be removed and reset, the limits of which will be determined in the field by the Engineer. This work would be paid for under the per CY price for resetting stone masonry, as described on Payment Note 5 on Sheet 1 of the plans. Q2-1: In the construction sequence table #2 construct precast concrete block retaining wall follows by (Town). Is it to be understood that the Town will be supplying concrete blocks required and contractor will perform all work related to installation? No. the Contractor will not be responsible for any work that is labeled as "Town" or "By Town" A2-1: on the construction plans. This work will be performed by the Town Highway Department, as described in the Construction Sequence and Payment Notes 7 and 8 on Sheet 1 of the plans.
