
Ferry Park



Located at the west end of Ferry Lane, this is a little gem of a park beside the Ferry Landing in the Nayaug section of South Glastonbury. The Glastonbury-Rocky Hill ferry route began in 1655 and is the oldest continuously operating ferry in the nation. There are picnic tables and benches. The half-mile loop trail is handicapped accessible. A portable toilet is available spring through fall.

This is a fine place to spend some time in any season. Spring and fall afternoons you will be able to watch the Glastonbury High School crew team practicing on the river.
